

Uninterrupted Worship

➤ The Worship

- Perpetual service. In an important sense the worship of the Hebrews was incessant.
- At the inauguration of the tabernacle service by the consecration of Aaron and his sons fire fell from heaven upon the altar of burnt sacrifices Lev. 9:1-24
- They were commanded to keep it burning continually Lev. 6:12-13
- They were also required to keep the golden lamps in the holy place burning continually Lev. 24:1-3
- The showbread was "set in order before the Lord continually" Lev. 24:5-9
- Important fact—Elements of the service.
 - The continual service was characterized by bread, sacrifice & life

➤ Will-Worship:

- In Col 2:23 "a show of wisdom in will-worship," worship originating in the human will as opposed to the divine, arbitrary religious acts, worthless despite their difficulty of performance.

➤ Call To Worship & Obedience

- Key to praise is 'Thanksgiving'
- Key to entering into His Presence is to come humbly with abundant praise
- Satisfaction of being in His presence is rest
