- ✚ Your Destiny Requires Obedience For Fulfillment
 - Your Destiny is a conditional promise
 - Webster's definition is quite different from the Biblical perspective. Experiencing our Divine Destiny requires our participation. We can forfeit the Destiny that God has for us individually and corporately
 - Examples of forfeiture.
 - Samson, Judges 13:5, 14, 16:15-27
 - King Saul 1 Samuel 10:24
 - Our Biblical Destiny is a beautiful gift that God gives to us that is only realized as we walk in obedience to God's way. Know this, it is conditional based upon our response
- ✚ Our process is as important as the fulfillment
